The Italian Cooperation has been present in Viet Nam since 1990 when the first Financial Technical Cooperation Agreement was signed between the two countries. Since then, the Italian Cooperation has been acting as a strategic partner to Viet Nam on its sustainable development path.





The Italian Cooperation provides technical assistance, financial support and policy advice in the areas of poverty eradication and human development, such as: health, WASH, climate change mitigation and adaptation, support for economic development, promotion of gender equality and equal opportunities.
